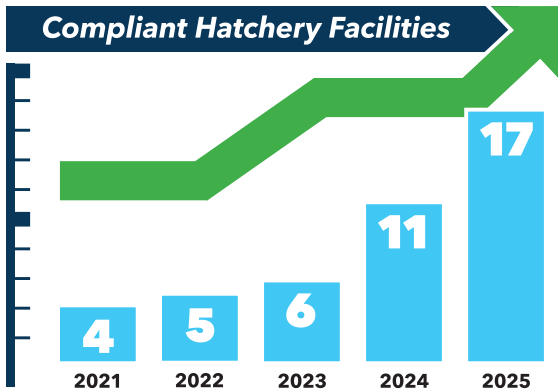

### HATCHERY BIOSECURITY COMPLIANCE PROGRAM

Voluntary Program for hatchery facilities to demonstrate compliance with the RSSBP Best Management Practices. Includes annual audits.

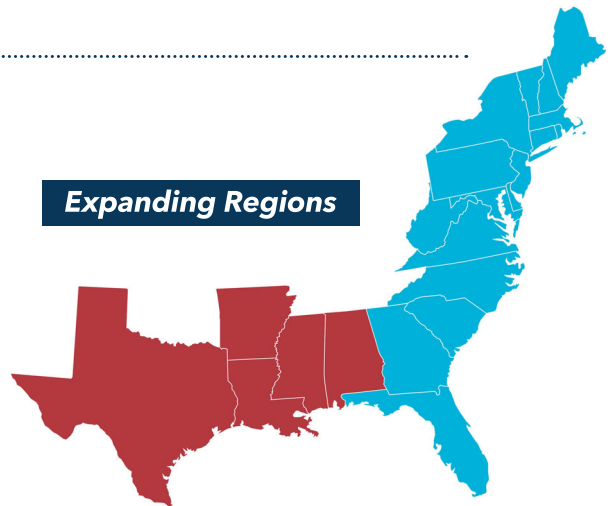
- Steady expansion in numbers of BMP-compliant facilities and geographic locations
- Increasing adoption and/or consideration by state regulatory agencies for seed transfers
- Focus on increasing auditor capacity and auditor training

### SHELLFISH HEALTH ADVISORY COUNCIL

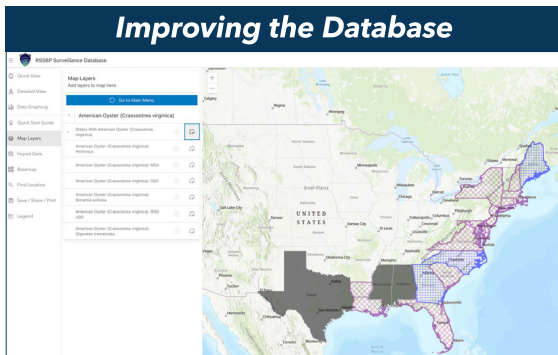
Coordinating body to ensure the best available science informs the program.

- Added US Gulf of Mexico Coast as a region
- Providing guidance to inform seed transfer requests
- Assisting state agencies with incorporation and application of RSSBP into policies and regulation
- Collaborating with USDA to align RSSBP with the Comprehensive Aquaculture Health Program Standards (CAHPS)
